HOUSE RULES

We want you to have the best time while staying with us, so we have a few rules to make sure you stay safe and look after this lovely cabin for you and other to enjoy.

-  **Accommodation:**
Please take care of the cabin and surrounding area. Keep the cabin clean and tidy and leave everything as you found it. We have the cabin kitted out with appliances and utensils. We ask that you take care when using these and supervise children at all times. Chopping board, coaster and pot stands are provided for your use. Don't NOT use the bench in replacement of these.
-  **Grounds:**
Sunset Glamping is located on a family farm and it is extremely important to us that you remain safe during your stay. Please be careful as there can be machinery and animals around.
-  **No Parties:**
We do not permit parties or events on site or in the cabin. Take time to relax and enjoy the country side and a slower pace of life.
-  **No Unregistered Guests:**
The cabin has been furnished to cater for and sleep four guests comfortably. A travel cot and High chair can be made available upon request. All Guest must be register to stay.
-  **Turn Off Lights:**
When the lights and electrical equipment are not in use or you are not in the cabin please remember to turn them off.



HOUSE RULES



No Smoking:

Smoking or vaping are not permitted in the cabin. Smoking is prohibited on the decking, Please use designated area where cigarette bins are provided. Please use these and keep the premises clean and tidy otherwise an additional cleaning fee may be charged. No illegal substances are permitted on the premises.



Linen:

We have provided white linen, robes and towels and we would ask that these are not stained by fake tan, makeup, beverages etc an additional cleaning or replacement fee will be charged.



Pets:

Due to animals on the farm and livestock in neighbouring fields unfortunately we cannot permit animals to stay.



Hot tub:

We want the hot tub to be enjoyed by many and therefore ask that you follow the rules provided later in the booklet and in the hot tub area.



BBQ:

If using portable BBQ please use station provided. Do not place on wood at any time. Leave on station provided to cool. Decking must be left tidy.



TV & WIFI:

Sunset Glamping has been designed and created to enable you to get away from the busyness of life and this includes technology. As a result there is no TV or WIFI. This will give you the perfect opportunity to enjoy tranquillity and the beauty of nature.



HOUSE RULES



Bins:

There are two bins in the sink area. 1 For general rubbish and 1 for food waste. Please use appropriate bin and do not leave rubbish around the cabin or decking. Bin is also provided in cabin and bathroom.



Toilets:

Do not flush anything other than the toilet paper provided. A toilet brush has been placed beside each toilet and we would appreciate it if you could use this when required.



Breakages:

We understand that accidents can happen. But we ask that you take care while staying. Please be careful while clearing breakages and report this to us as soon as possible. There will be a charge for replacement of damaged or broken items.



Unreasonable behaviour:

Poor behaviour is not tolerated on site. Sunset glamping is a reputable holiday accommodation for our guest to enjoy and explore, so please keep this in mind during your stay.



Enjoy your stay:

Finally, you are here to relax and unwind so it is a must that you have a good time.

HOT TUB RULES

We have provided a hot tub for your enjoyment while you stay at the cabin. Please take note of the rules we have put in place to keep everyone safe and to take care of the hot tub for others to enjoy.

- ✓ Use of the hot tub is allowed between the hours of 8am - 12am
- ✓ Fake tan is not permitted in the hot tub. Specialised cleaning would be required to remove tan stains and the filters are unable to clean tan from the water. This therefore would result in an excess charge applied to your bill.
- ✓ Please shower before using the hot tub.
- ✓ Acrylic tumblers and acrylic wine glasses are provided in the kitchen, these are the only glasses permitted outside. Glasses are not permitted in the hot tub due to risk of broken glass as the hot tub would need to be evacuated and drained immediately.
- ✓ Clean swim wear should be worn in the hot tub at all times.
- ✓ It is advisable to get acclimatised to using the hot tub so initial use should be for a maximum of 15 minutes at a time.
- ✓ The consumption of alcohol is not permitted in conjunction with the use of the hot tub due to health risks.
- ✓ Do not add any substances to the hot tub, e.g. drinks, bubble bath, lotions etc.
- ✓ Those with heart conditions, high blood pressure, who are pregnant or suffer from other health conditions should not use the hot tub due to health risks.
- ✓ Only children above the age of 5 are permitted in the hot tub and must be supervised at all times.
- ✓ The chemical levels in the hot tub are tested for safety and hygiene purposes on a daily basis, it goes without saying that the hot tub is not a toilet.
- ✓ Please ensure the lid is fully open before entering the tub and that the lid is closed after use.
- ✓ We have provided robes for your use we ask that you take care of these and bring them inside after using them at the tub. Please dry off where possible before re-entering the cabin.

HEATING SYSTEM

The thermostat is located on the right hand side of the cabin wall. The heating is set to the maximum temperature and is on a automatic timer to provide you with the most comfortable temperature. Please do not adjust the timer settings. If the cabins gets too cold you can boost the heating by pressing the boost button once and pressing the tick button. If the Cabin gets too warm you can lower the temperature by pressing the down arrows to the desired temperature and pressing the tick button.

PLEASE BE AWARE THAT THE THERMOSAT HAS A DOOR OPEN SENSOR AND WILL TURN OFF THE HEAT WHEN THE DOOR IS OPEN SO PLEASE KEEP DOOR CLOSED AT ALL TIMES.
